- The type of projects that a fully qualified Heritage Engineering Technician might work on for example are; 'dismantling and rebuilding a vintage/classic car or renovating an aircraft for a museum exhibit from scratch'.
- Examples of job titles that are included within the Heritage Engineering Technician include the following:

Heritage Aviation Technician, Heritage Marine Technician, Heritage Steam Technician and Heritage Vehicle Technician.

 Undertaking the work activity using the correct, tools, processes, procedures and equipment.


 Planning and where applicable obtaining all the resources required to undertake the work activity.
